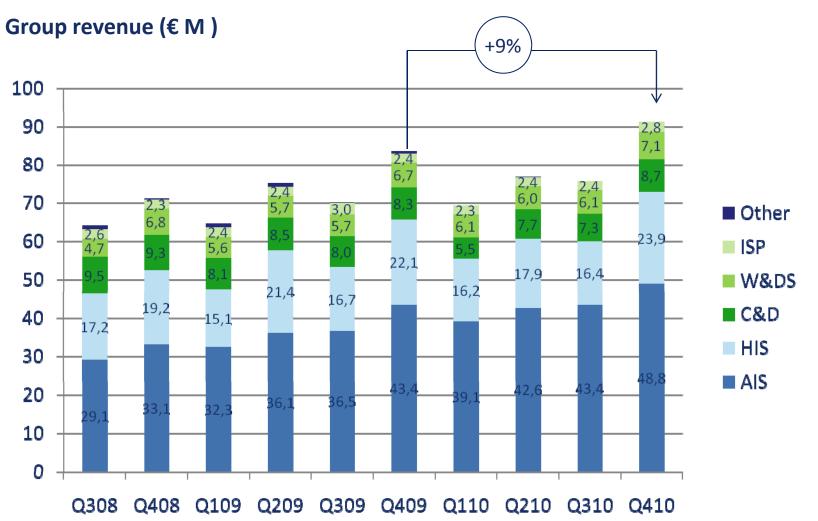

Sequential revenue development









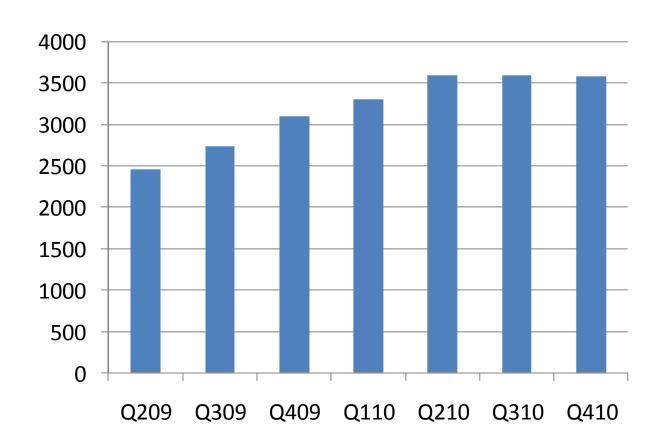
- Solid finish to the year in HIS
- 4th quarter AIS revenue lower than expected due to low business volume in USA
- It has taken longer than planned to focus the US business on the new market growth opportunities and this causes a delay in revenue effects from the HITECH stimulus

- In Workflow & Decision Support, no revenue has been recognized to date from the variable component of the running SmartExchange contracts as the outcomes-based data is still under evaluation.



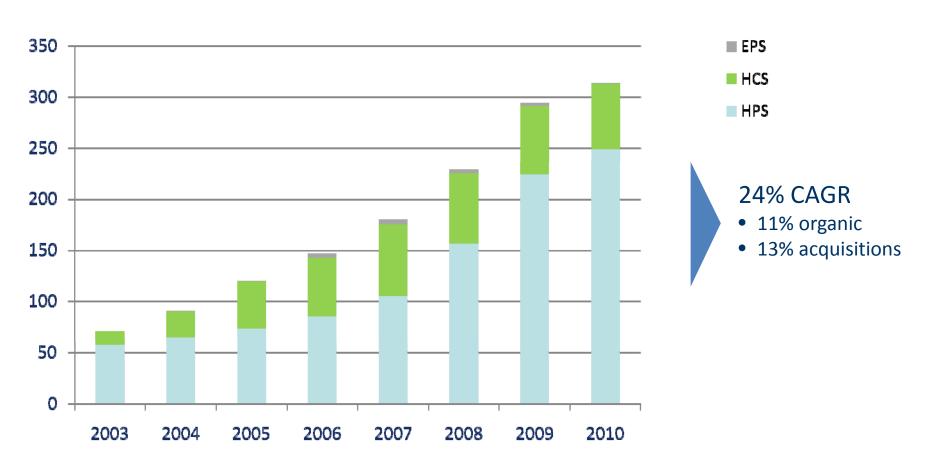


- Direct transaction expenses related to acquisitions of EUR 1.5 million

Revenue growth – last 7 years

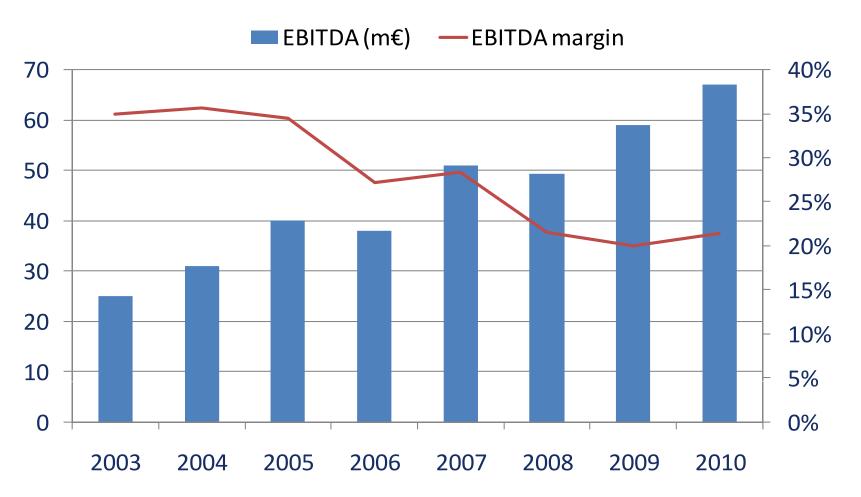


Group revenue (€ M)



Operating margin during growth

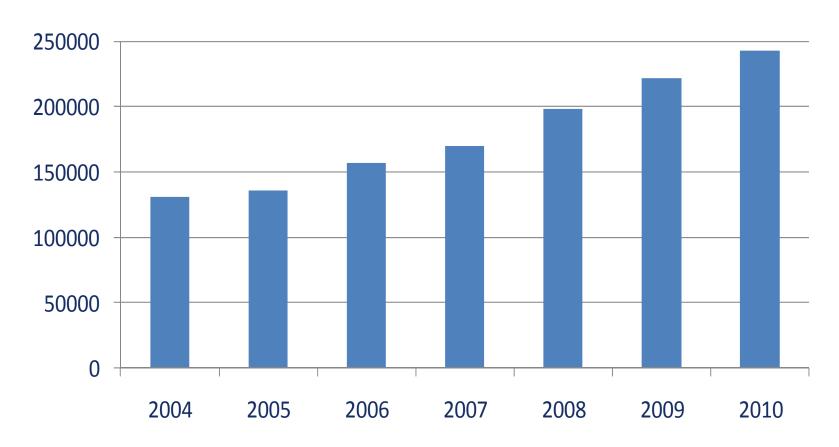








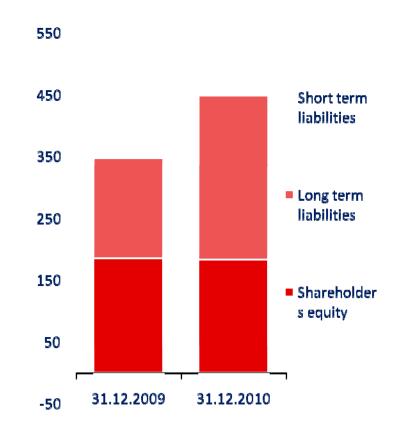
Number of doctors / dentists with software maintenance contract (end period)

Third US transaction: Healthport



- Acquisition of HealthPort's Solutions Division based in Columbia, South Carolina
- Healthport is a provider of practice management software, electronic health records and revenue cycle management services (EDI/RCM) to approximately 3.600 doctors in physician practices, community health centers and hospitals in the USA.
- Total sales in 2009 were about \$28.0 million and EBITDA was about \$1.9 million. For 2010 the company expects revenues of about \$28.0 million with an EBITDA of about \$2.9 million.
- CompuGroup is now an IT supplier to approximately 18,000 doctors in USA through Noteworthy Medical Systems, Visionary Healthware and Healthport

Market entries in Benelux



- Netherlands: Ascon Software B.V. (brand name: Euroned)
 - Provider of AIS and pharmacy systems
 - 80 employees located in Echt



- Customers: 700 GPs (10% market share), 430 pharmacies (20% market share)
- Revenue 2010 ~€10.8 million (65% recurring) and EBITDA €2.8 million
- Belgium: Belgiedata BVBA
 - Belgian market leader in AIS (WINDOC) with 25% market share
 - 6 employees located in Gent
 - 2,300 customers
 - Revenue 2010 ~€0.7 million and EBITDA €145,000



CGM enters Suisse market



- Acquisition of MCS Parametrix AG Schweiz including MCS Parametrix Deutschland GmbH
- Mospital Information Systems market leader in Switzerland
- Market share: ~30% acute hospitals, ~20% reha clinics
- Located in Niederwangen, CH
- Product: "Phoenix" (HIS)
- Maintenance contracts with 39 customers
- Revenue 2010E of acquired assets: ~ €6.0 million





- Acuiqisition of HIS provider SIVSA
- Market leader in north-west Spain, additional operations in Portugal, Brazil, Chile and Morocco
- 56 employees, headquarter in Vigo (Galicia)
- 37 customers: 21 hospitals in Spain, 2 in Portugal, 10 in Brazil, 1 in Chile and 3 in Morocco
- Estimated 2010 revenue €3.4 million and EBITDA €350,000
- ISO 9001:2000 certified company



Acquisition in Scandinavia



- Acquisition of Swedish Lorensbergs Holding AB
- Lorensbergs offers software solutions for occupational healthcare, general practitioners and school healthcare in Sweden
- Occupational healthcare customers also in Norway
- 41 employees located in Gothenburg
- Revenue 2010: ~€3.7 million



Acquisition of remaining 50% in HCS



- Since 1995, HCS has become the leading company in Austria for transfer of all kinds of medical data in electronic format
- Customers are:
 - 2326 doctor offices (GPs, specialists)
 - 120 hospitals
 - 119 radiologists
 - 77 laboratories
 - 24 insurance companies
- 12 Million messages transferred in 2010, driven with own ITservices in a rented datacenter
- 13 employees located in Altlengbach (lower Austria, Austria)
- 2010E revenue of € 2.2 million



OUTLOOK

Outlook 2011



- The annual software maintenance and other recurring revenue from existing customers is EUR 235 million at the beginning of 2011 compared to EUR 180 million at the beginning of 2010
- The HIS order backlog and pipeline is stronger than last year and a number of new add-on products are ready for the AIS market in Germany
- New regional contracts have been signed in Scandinavia and a special ASP/hosting adoption drive will be a focus area in this region throughout 2011
- For the US, we expect a significant market impact from the HITECH stimulus in 2011 and CompuGroup is now reorganizing the US business to drive stronger growth and performance





- In HCS we expect Communication and Data to grow for the first time in 3 years
- We also see a gradual uptake of new customers in Workflow & Decision Support and ISP
- The organic growth rate is expected to be approximately 10 percent in 2011 in both the HPS and HCS segments
- Acquisitions completed to date are expected to give a further growth contribution of around 20 percent, all in the HPS segment
- 2011 will also be the first year with external revenue in CHS, however still at modest levels.

Guidance 2011



- CompuGroup Medical offers the following guidance for 2011:
 - Revenue is expected to be in the range of €395 million to €420 million
 - Operating income (EBITDA) is expected to be in the range of €86 million to €93 million
- The guidance for 2011 represents management's best estimate of the market conditions that will exist in 2011 and how the business segments of CompuGroup Medical will perform in this environment
- The guidance does not include revenue and costs associated with potential and currently undetermined further acquisitions during 2011
