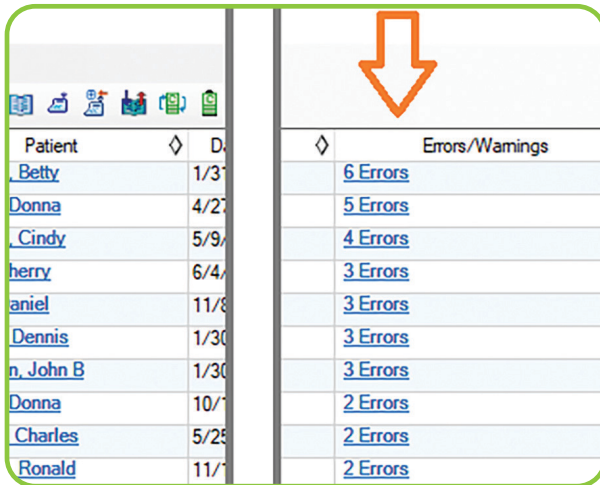

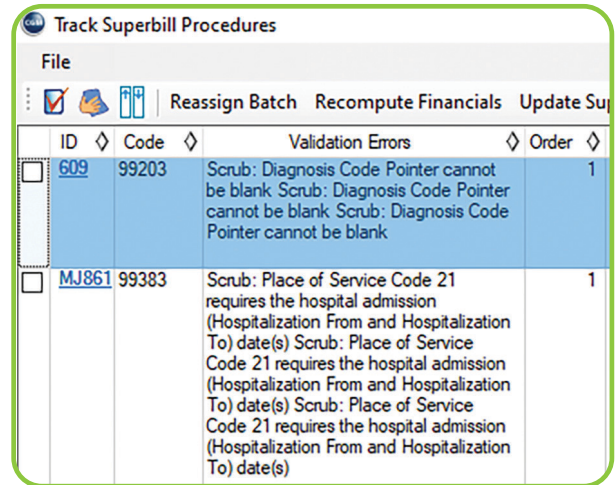

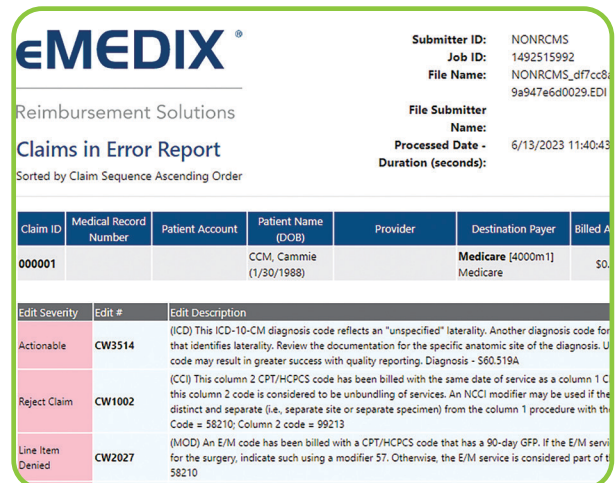

Edit Severity	Edit #	Edit Description
Actionable	CW3514	(ICD) This ICD-10-CM diagnosis code reflects an "unspecified" laterality. Another diagnosis code for that identifies laterality. Review the documentation for the specific anatomic site of the diagnosis. U code may result in greater success with quality reporting. Diagnosis - \$60.5194
Reject Claim	CW1002	(CCI) This column 2 CPT/HCPCS code has been billed with the same date of service as a column 1 CPT/HCPCS code. This column 2 code is considered to be unbundling of services. Line Item Denied	CW2027	(MOD) An E/M code has been billed with a CPT/HCPCS code that has a 90-day GFP. If the E/M service is for the surgery, indicate such using a modifier 57. Otherwise, the E/M service is considered part of the surgery.
